

CONSTITUTION

KNOX COUNTY JUNIOR FAIR BOARD

ARTICLE I - TITLE

This organization shall be known as the Knox County Junior Fair Board.

ARTICLE II - OBJECT

The object of this group shall be to promote the interests of the Knox County youth through their exhibits and activities at the Knox County Fair. Whenever possible, activities of junior exhibitors shall be coordinated for the benefit of the total group. The members and officers of this organization shall at all times cooperate with and be under the direction of and supervision of the Junior Fair Coordinator and the Knox County Senior Fair Board. They shall cooperate and assist the Senior Fair Board in carrying out the activities of the Knox County Fair.

ARTICLE III - MEMBERSHIP

Membership on the Knox County Junior Fair Board shall consist of a member or members representing 4-H Clubs, FFA Chapter, FCCLA Chapters, Girl Scouts, Boy Scouts, Junior Grange and other youth organizations to the Senior Fair Board.

ARTICLE IV - ORGANIZATIONS & MEETINGS

1. The Junior Fair Board members shall meet and elect the following officers. President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer & Reporter to serve one year and until their successors are elected and qualified.
2. All officers shall be elected from the membership of the Board.
3. Meetings of the Junior Fair Board may be called by the President or Junior Fair Coordinator of the Junior Fair Board.
4. The organizational meeting of the Junior Fair Board will be held in December of each year with additional meetings as called by the President or Coordinator.
5. Any board member missing two Board meetings without good cause will be dropped from the board.

ARTICLE V

1. The Board shall consist of 4-H Club members, three F.F.A. members per participating chapter, three FCCLA member per participating chapter, three representatives from the Girl Scouts, three representatives from Boy Scouts, and three representatives from Junior Grange.

2. The selection of the Board members will be supervised by the adult leaders of the organization represented.
3. All members are to serve one-year terms. Members may serve no more than three terms.
4. All board members shall be at least 14 years of age as of January 1 of the current year.

ARTICLE VI - DUTIES OF OFFICERS

1. It shall be the duty of the President to preside at the sessions of the Board, see that the rules of the organization are enforced and supervise the Departments of the Knox County Junior Fair.
2. It shall be the duty of the Vice President to assume the duties of the President in his absence, and to direct the special activities of the Board under the supervision of the President.
3. It shall be the duty of the Secretary to record the minutes of the meeting of the organization, receive and conduct the correspondence, to provide for publicity and shall report to each organization the log of time worked by each member of their organization.
4. It shall be the duty of the Treasurer to receive and discharge all funds belonging to the organization.
5. It shall be the duty of the Reporter to gather information regarding the organization's activities and communicate those activities with the appropriate media.

ARTICLE VII - AMENDMENTS

An amendment must first be approved by the Advisory committees of the organizations representing the Board. It shall then be submitted to the members of the Junior Fair Board in writing at least one week prior to the meeting on which action is taken. A two-thirds vote of the Junior Fair Board membership must be in favor of any amendments added to the constitution.
